### PROJECT GOAL

To examine the extent to which essential reproductive health *equipment* and *consumable* insecurity impedes the achievement of national and global family planning goals.

Reliable point-of-service availability of essential reproductive health equipment and consumables - including forceps, specula, cotton, antiseptic, and gloves - is critical for high-quality, comprehensive family planning service delivery. We aim to gain a deeper understanding of reproductive health supply challenges, as they relate to equipment and consumables, and to prioritize opportunities for strategic action.

# **Methods**

## Uganda and Nepal

- For both consultations, we convened roughly 30 supply chain experts from national government, district health offices, public and private procurement bodies, and implementing partners.
- We focused on characterizing the existing supply chain for family planning equipment and consumables and exploring subnational and point-of-service diversity in quantification, procurement, distribution, acquisition, and monitoring through discussion and systems mapping exercises.
- We collaboratively identified strengths, weaknesses and opportunities within the
  existing equipment and consumable reproductive health and family planning supply
  chain using a human-centered design approach.
- We defined strategic opportunities to support sustainable equipment and consumable security within facilities providing an expanded method mix and/or serving a growing family planning user-base.
