Introduction: Federal Nepal

In the aftermath of the <u>2007 People's Revolt II</u>, the 240 years of monarchy was abolished in the 5th amendment of the Interim Constitution of Nepal, 2007. The amendment was the first document to mention Nepal officially as the Federal Democratic Republic of Nepal. It envisioned <u>federalism</u> as a prominent feature for a new Nepal.

Local level election was held in 2017, and in mid-2018 actual federal

structure started taking shape.







- From 1970s China started to carry out free contraceptives supply policy and gradually formed free of charge supply system.
- In 2012 free contraceptives were included in national basic public service system.
- In 2017 listed in national basic public health service program.






Contraceptives Commodity Supplies in China










Evolvement and reform ongoing
