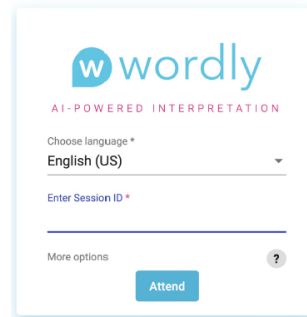

CURRENT GOAL

to increase, expand, and improve access to a wide range of high quality, affordable menstrual health products

MENSTRUAL HEALTH SUPPLIES WORKSTREAM

CURRENT OUTCOMES

1. Menstrual health is integrated into the broader Coalition strategy for RH supplies.
2. **[AVAILABILITY]** Improved understanding of menstrual health supply chains for informing policy and programs at the global and country levels.
3. **[QUALITY]** Minimum quality standards developed for all types of menstrual products.
4. **[CHOICE]** Stakeholders who procure products have access to reliable information on and are aware of the range of menstrual health products available.
5. **[EQUITY]** Access to affordable, acceptable menstrual health products increased for all menstruators.

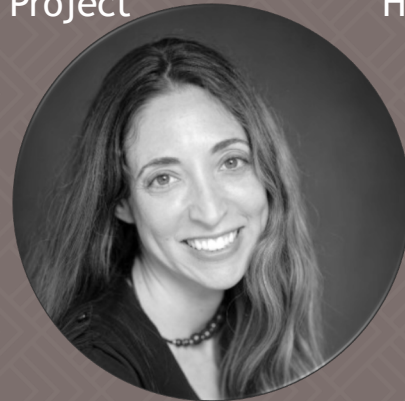
